Latest News:

- Nov 30 **SAP Business One will no longer give any support statements on virtualization software**. Effectively immediately, SAP Business One will no longer provide any support statements on virtualization software as we consider it the virtualization vendor's responsibility to ensure operating system compatibility. SAP Business One is running on virtualization software just as it is running on non-virtualized operating system platforms.
 - In general, only the **English** platform versions are supported. Platform versions in other languages are supported as long as the issue is **not specific** to the platform version in a particular language.
 - SAP will test only major versions of Microsoft's operating systems, databases and Office software
 products. Service Packs delivered by Microsoft in the course of a product's lifecycle will no longer
 be tested separately, but will automatically be officially supported for SAP Business One.
 - If you encounter an issue with any of the Microsoft product Service Packs, SAP will solve this issue on a case-by-case basis as a bug (historically low rate of occurrence).

Example:

Your system is required to run:

- 4 SAP Add-Ons
- 1 Solution Add-On
- 10 SAP Business One users

Calculate the required memory as follows:

- All Add-Ons require 60 MB x 1 SAP Add-On + 25 MB x 3 SAP Add-Ons + 60 MB x 1 Solution Add-On = 200 MB ~ 300 MB for all five Add-Ons
- Each user requires 60 MB ~ 80 MB (application) + 200 MB ~ 300 MB (Add-Ons) + 40 MB ~ 50 MB (Citrix session) = 300 MB ~ 430 MB x 10 users = **3 GB 4 GB** in total
